



Professional Counselling CLINICAL COUNSELLOR

35 hour / week one year temporary contract position

The Professional Counselling (PC) Program is seeking a motivated and energetic individual to join our clinical team. This position will include work in our Peaceful Families program and in Havelock providing outreach.

The successful applicant will possess a solid theoretical knowledge of clinical presentations, proven assessment skills and experience providing clinical counselling services to individuals, couples, and families. The clinical counsellor will also be involved in group facilitation within the Professional Counselling team. An understanding of issues related to violence and poverty, diversity, and a commitment to social justice is required.

Qualifications for this position include a **Master degree in Social Work or Counselling** or equivalent, and two or more years of clinical experience. Registration with the OCSWSSW, or CRPO or eligibility for registration is required. The successful candidate will have a proven ability to work independently and as part of a team; excellent oral and written communication skills and crisis intervention skills. The successful applicant will be willing to travel within Peterborough county and possess a valid driver's licence to provide outreach services in Havelock. Previous experience working with children / youth, employee assistance clients, and providing trauma informed counselling are definite assets.

This is a 35 hour per week temporary contract position, commencing February 10th, 2020 until February 21, 2021 and reporting to the manager of Professional Counselling. There is a requirement to work one evening per week. Starting salary is \$28.58 per hour. The position is contingent on continued funding.
