The Professional Counselling (PC) Program is seeking a **Clinical Counsellor** to join our professional counselling team. This position will provide clinical counselling services to residents of Peterborough City and County, and to clients of the Family Services Employee Assistance Program (FSEAP).

The successful applicant will possess a solid theoretical knowledge of clinical presentations, proven assessment skills and experience providing clinical counselling services to individuals, couples, and families. The clinical counsellor will also be involved in group facilitation, client screening, crisis intervention including risk assessment and safety planning within the Professional Counselling team. An understanding of issues related to violence and poverty, diversity, and a commitment to social justice is required.

Qualifications for this position include a **Master degree in Social Work or Counselling** or equivalent, with five or more years of clinical experience preferred. Current liability insurance and registration with the OCSWSSW, or CRPO or eligibility for registration is required. The successful candidate will have a proven ability to work independently and as part of a team and demonstrate excellent verbal and written communication skills and crisis intervention skills. Previous experience working with employee assistance clients, and providing single session therapy, trauma informed counselling, and critical incident response are definite assets.

This is a 35 hour per week permanent position, and is eligible for benefits. There is a requirement to work one evening per week. Starting salary is \$29.25 per hour. Start date ASAP.
