Commitments & Expectations

- Board terms begin/renew at the Annual General Meeting and directors are elected to serve a two year term. Directors may serve up to three consecutive terms.
- The board of directors meets a minimum of 6 times per year. Board members are also expected to contribute to committees and other ad-hoc projects. Time commitments run an average of 5-10 hours per month.
- New board members are expected to participate in an orientation program.
- All board members are expected to contribute to the operational fundraising of the
 organization, which may include a personal donation, supporting outreach initiatives,
 or thanking donors.

• Each board member has a legal responsibility to participate actively in making decisions on behalf of the organization and to exercise their best judgment while doing so.
