The successful applicant will possess a solid theoretical knowledge of clinical presentations, proven assessment skills and experience providing clinical counselling services to individuals. The clinical counsellor may also be involved in group facilitation, client screening, crisis intervention including risk assessment and safety planning within the Professional Counselling team. An understanding of issues related to violence and poverty, diversity, and a commitment to social justice is required.

Qualifications for this position include a **Master degree in Social Work or Counselling** or equivalent, and clinical experience. Current liability insurance and registration with the OCSWSSW, or CRPO or eligibility for registration is required. The successful candidate will have a proven ability to work independently and as part of a team and demonstrate excellent verbal and written communication skills and crisis intervention skills.
