PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

CCRC's Professional Counselling Program (PC) provides clinical counselling on a sliding fee scale with no one turned away for an inability to pay. We offer counselling for mild to moderate mental health concerns using a short to mid-term model (6-12 sessions).

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF ROLES

The Clinical Counsellor will provide individual, couples and family counselling. The role also includes group facilitation, client screening, crisis intervention including risk assessment and safety planning. This position works within the Professional Counselling team, attending weekly clinical team meetings and receiving supervision from the Clinical Team Lead.

CONTRACT DETAILS

CCRC is seeking one contract full-time **Clinical Counsellor** to start as soon as possible. The starting salary is **\$33.02 per hour for 35 hours per week**. The pay range is \$33.02 - \$40.21 per hour.

Total compensation includes two weeks paid vacation, MERCs, casual dress and paid sick leave. Regular hours of work are 8:30am to 4:30pm with the expectation to be available one day per week until 8:00 p.m.
