Anyone searching for rental housing, or having a problem with their housing is welcome to access the space to use the computers, telephones, fax machine and printer. HRC staff are available to provide support and guidance throughout the process of searching for rental housing.

When accessing any of our HRC Services, please bring documents you think might be helpful, including ID, eviction notices, rent receipts, utility bills, rental application forms, paystubs, OW/ODSP statements etc.

Our Drop-in Housing Help Clinic operates from 9:30 - 4 pm Monday to Friday (closed from 12-1 for lunch).


