The Professional Counselling (PC) Program is seeking a **Clinical Counsellor** to join our professional counselling team. In a new partnership with the City of Kawartha Lakes, this exciting new position will provide clinical counselling services to residents of the City of Kawartha Lakes who are in receipt of Ontario Works. The position will be based out of Lindsay with some travel to Haliburton and Peterborough, with mileage between sites provided.

The successful applicant will possess a solid theoretical knowledge of clinical presentations, proven assessment skills and experience providing clinical counselling. The clinical counsellor will also be involved in client screening, crisis intervention including risk assessment and safety planning. An understanding of issues related to violence and poverty, diversity, and a commitment to social justice is required.

Qualifications for this position include a **Master degree in Social Work or Counselling** or equivalent, with clinical experience preferred. Current liability insurance and registration with the OCSWSSW, or CRPO or eligibility for registration is required. The successful candidate will have a proven ability to work independently and as part of a team and demonstrate excellent verbal and written communication skills and crisis intervention skills.

This is a 35 hour per week one year contract position with possibility of renewal. Salary range is \$30.86 to \$37.59 per hour with annual step increases. Two weeks paid vacation, paid shut down between Christmas and New Years and generous medical leave provided. CCRC reimburses for college registration and liability insurance and also provides opportunities for professional development.
