The Professional Counselling (PC) Program is seeking a **Clinical Team Lead** to join our Professional Counselling team. This position will provide clinical oversight to the Professional Counselling team and clinical counselling services in both community and EAP programs. The Professional Counselling team serves Peterborough City and County, Northumberland and the City of Kawartha Lakes. The Clinical Team Lead will be based out of our Peterborough location with some opportunity for remote work.

The successful applicant will possess a solid theoretical knowledge of clinical presentations, proven assessment skills and experience providing clinical supervision and counselling services to individuals, couples, and families. The Clinical Team Lead may be involved in group facilitation, critical incident response and workshop provision within the Professional Counselling team. An understanding of issues related to violence and poverty, diversity, and a commitment to social justice is required.

Qualifications for this position include a **Master degree in Social Work, Counselling** or equivalent, **five or more years of clinical experience** and **two years of clinical supervision experience** preferred. Current liability insurance and registration with the OCSWSSW or CRPO is required. The successful candidate will have a proven ability to work independently and as part of a team and demonstrate excellent verbal and written communication skills and crisis intervention skills. Previous experience working with employee assistance clients, trauma informed counselling, and critical incident response are definite assets.

This is a 35 hour per week 18 month contract covering a parental leave. There is a requirement to work one evening per week. Start date October 10, 2023. Salary range is \$33.12 to \$39.85/hour with annual step increases. This position has generous medical leave, three weeks annual vacation as well as a paid shut down between Christmas and New Years Day.
